We are writing as members of Keep Antibiotics Working, a coalition representing more than 11 million supporters concerned about the health impacts of overuse of antibiotics in livestock and poultry production. We support changes to both public policy and in the marketplace to help reduce antibiotic overuse in animal agriculture. In terms of the latter, we have worked in the past with major purchasers of pork raised with fewer or no antibiotics, including Chipotle, McDonald's, and Compass.
